The Adult Migrant English Program (AMEP) wants to make sure you and your teachers are safe and that you can continue to learn English during the COVID-19 pandemic.

That is why in March 2020, the Department of Home Affairs (who are responsible for the AMEP) encouraged your AMEP provider to look at ways for your learning to continue in a way that keeps you safe and follows the latest medical advice on COVID-19 issued by the Government. This may include options you can do at home, such as online classes and paper workbooks.

It is not clear how long the COVID-19 arrangements will need to stay in place, but your provider will stay in touch with you and let you know as soon as normal classroom learning can start again.
