Carry out the sessions you've agreed to do responsibly, reliably and ethically—this includes respecting the rights and privacy of others. Contact VTS staff if you are concerned about a student's welfare Inform VTS Office if your availability changes Give two weeks' notice before withdrawing from the program Complete an Exit Survey
